SHG's SCRIP Program

What is SCRIP?

Scrip is a tuition reimbursement program. When parents, grandparents, friends purchase SCRIP gift cards, they are purchasing negotiable gift cards (not a credit card) that may be used just like cash. National and local retailers use these gift cards where our families already shop. These merchants want to support the schools, and in return ask you to support them by shopping with SCRIP at their stores. The individuals who sign up with SCRIP through SHG can use the gift cards to purchase everyday expenses such as food, clothing, gas, etc. You can plan ahead for "occasions" as well: Graduations, Mother's Day, Father's Day, Birthdays, Christmas, etc. These individuals can then earn revenue for a designated child's tuition with every purchase.

Why should I participate?

Participating retailers "give back" a percentage (2% - 15% or more) of the face value of the gift certificate to SHG. Ninety-four percent of this amount will be applied to the student's tuition for the following school year.

How do I participate?

First, will sign up on the RaiseRight page. Ashley Pennell can provide you with a link with the enrollment code to complete the registration. Once registered, you may begin ordering your SCRIP certificates. To order online, visit <u>www.raiseright.com.</u>

Individuals have three payment options upon placing an order. First, place your purchases on the RaiseRight website and then forward a check to SHG by 9:00a.m. on Mondays. Alternately, you may choose "Presto Pay". This allows you to have your scrip payment deducted directly from your bank account. The third payment option is using your credit card.

Orders will be available for pick up in the Finance Office later in the week.
